



抗战胜利勋章(Order of the War of Resistance Victory)是中国抗日战争结束后中华民国国民政府授予抗战有功人士的勋章。民国三十四年(1945年)10月8日,国民政府军事委员会国防最高委员会通过了《颁给胜利勋章案》。10月10日公布《颁给胜利勋章条例》。次年1月8日,又修正为《颁给胜利勋奖章条例》。该勋章为襟绶有表,不分等级。

首批获授胜利勋章的共有94人。在此之后,双十节期间共颁布了十余 道授勋令,有近千人获颁胜利勋章。国民政府公报从1945年10月10 日陆续公布颁发名单,截止1950年,总计颁发22498枚。中共方面有 毛泽东、董必武、朱德、彭德怀、叶剑英亦获此勋章。

抗战胜利勋章为金色八角芒星,圆形中心为时任国民政府主席的蒋中正头像,中心像周围为红底八颗金星,与芒星之间为多层光芒,章体和吊环之间有一章环,为黄绿嘉禾环绕国徽,银质多层结构,背面有一圆环,中间是中国地图,地图上有繁体文字"八年抗战胜利纪念"字样,圆环上面是制作局戳印,下面是编号。绶带为中间为红色,两边为白底蓝条。



梅縣曾氏,地方名流、旅港華僑。此輯推出的曾氏家藏書畫,包含民國大家、清代翰林名家書法、對聯凡140餘件,據標籤款識,或上世紀中葉於港入藏,二代而未曾有一面世。挑選代表者四十件(第一部分)於29964號拍賣會,其餘各種(第二部分)由同期網拍29965號盡數釋出。

曾氏藏畫,以滬上及粵中名家為代表。26號李苦禪《春聲》,由李氏自題簽條,又二題畫心見贈「德堅」先生,亦即曾氏上代舊主。24號吳湖帆《墨竹》,遙應吳氏經眼王孟端畫竹,現藏北京故宮博物館,上款上海金石書畫聯誼社顧功模,不知是否其時流入曾氏家藏。27號程十髮等合作隔景山水,乃程氏罕見絕早期山水,薄施翠黛,清新淡雅。

曾氏似乎對書法收集頗有執著的主題方向。 其書法對聯,廣集清末名家如翁同龢(37號)、翁方綱(38號)、李瑞清(44號),諸生、翰林、進士三鼎甲如趙叔儒(40號)、商衍鎏(50、51號)、朱汝珍(47、49號),不乏南方巨賈家常應有,上款各種,琳瑯滿目,亦收集如夏壽田書法張嘯林莫干山招遊實錄(57號),各中人物皆可對號入座,嵌入史實,嚴絲合縫,集韻增文,多見多聞。

DEFINITIONS and GLOSSARY

Where these Definitions and Glossary are incorporated, the following words and phrases used have (unless the context otherwise requires) the meanings given to them below. The Glossary is to assist you to understand words and phrases which have a specific legal meaning with which you may not be familiar.

LIST OF DEFINITIONS

- "ABN" means the same as ABN means in the A New Tax System (Australian Business Number) Act 1999. "Auctioneer" the representative of Bonhams conducting the
- "Bidder" a person who has completed a Bidding Form. "Bidding Form" our Bidding Registration Form, our Absentee Bidding Form or our Telephone Bidding Form.

 "Bonhams" Bonhams 1793 Limited or its successors or
- assigns. Bonhams is also referred to in the Buyer's Agreement, the Conditions of Business and the Notice to Bidders by the words "we", "us" and "our".
- "Book" a printed book offered for sale at a specialist book sale.
 "Business" includes any trade, business and profession.
- "Buyer" the person to whom a Lot is knocked down by the Auctioneer. The Buyer is also referred to in the Contract of Sale and the Buyer's Agreement by the words "you" and "your".
- "Buyer's Agreement" the contract entered into by Bonhams with the Buyer (see Appendix 2 in the Catalogue).
- "Buyer's Premium" the sum calculated on the Hammer Price at the rates stated in the Notice to Bidders.
- "Catalogue" the Catalogue relating to the relevant Sale including any representation of the Catalogue published on our
- "Commission" the commission payable by the Seller to Bonhams calculated at the rates stated in the Contract Form. "Condition Report" a report on the physical condition of a Lot provided to a Bidder or potential Bidder by Bonhams on behalf
- of the Seller. "Consignment Fee" a fee payable to Bonhams by the Selle calculated at rates set out in the Conditions of Business "Consumer" a consumer within the meaning of that term in the Trade Practices Act 1974.
- 'Contract Form" the contract form, or vehicle entry form, as applicable, signed by or on behalf of the Seller listing the Lots to be offered for sale by Bonhams.
- "Contract for Sale" the sale contract entered into by the Seller
- with the Buyer (see Appendix 1 in the Catalogue). "Contractual Description" the only description of the Lot (being that part of the Entry about the Lot in the Catalogue which is in bold letters, any photograph (except for the colour) and the contents of any Condition Report) to which the Seller undertakes in the Contract of Sale the Lot corresponds.
- "Description" any statement or representation in any way descriptive of the *Lot*, including any statement or representation relating to its authorship, attribution, condition, provenance, authenticity, style, period, age, suitability, quality, origin, value
- estimated selling price (including the Hammer Price).

 "Entry" a written statement in the Catalogue identifying the Lot and its Lot number which may contain a description and illustration(s) relating to the Lot.
- "Estimate" a statement of our opinion of the range within which the hammer is likely to fall
- **'Expenses"** charges and expenses paid or payable by Bonhams in respect of the *Lot* including legal expenses, banking charges and expenses incurred as a result of an electronic transfer of money, charges and expenses for loss and damage cover, catalogue and other reproductions and illustrations, any customs duties, advertising, packing or shipping costs, reproduction rights' fees, taxes (including GST), levies, costs of testing, searches or enquiries, preparation of the Lot for sale, storage charges, removal charges or costs of collection from the Seller as the Seller's agents or from a defaulting Buyer, plus GST if applicable.
- "Forgery" an imitation intended by the maker or any other

person to deceive as to authorship, attribution, origin, authenticity, style, date, age, period, provenance, culture, source or composition, which at the date of the Sale had a value materially less than it would have had if the *Lot* had not been such an imitation, and which is not stated to be such an imitation in any description of the Lot. A Lot will not be a Forgery by reason of any damage to, and/or restoration and/or modification work (including repainting or over painting) having been carried out on the Lot, where that damage, restoration or modification work (as the case may be) does not substantially affect the identity of the *Lot* as one conforming to the description of the Lot.

- "GST" means the same as GST means in the A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999.
- "Guarantee" the obligation undertaken personally by Bonhams to the Buyer in respect of any Forgery and, in the case of specialist Stamp sales and/or specialist Book sales, a Lot made up of a Stamp or Stamps or a Book or Books as set out in the Buyer's Agreement.

 "Hammer Price" the price in the currency in which the Sale
- is conducted (including GST, if any) at which a Lot is knocked down by the Auctione
- "Loss and Damage Warranty" means the warranty described
- in paragraph 8.2.1 of the Conditions of Business. "Loss and Damage Warranty Fee" means the fee described in paragraph 8.2.3 of the Conditions of Business.
- "Lot" any item consigned to Bonhams with a view to its sale at auction or by private treaty (and reference to any Lot will include, unless the context otherwise requires, reference to individual items comprised in a group of two or more items offered for sale as one Lot).

 "Motoring Catalogue Fee" a fee payable by the Seller to
- Bonhams in consideration of the additional work undertaken by Bonhams in respect of the cataloguing of motor vehicles and in respect of the promotion of sales of motor vehicles.
- "Notional Charges" the amount of Commission and GST which would have been payable if the Lot had been sold at the Notional Price.
- "Notional Fee" the sum on which the Consignment Fee payable to Bonhams by the Seller is based and which is calculated according to the formula set out in the Conditions of Business
- "Notional Price" the latest in time of the average of the high and low estimates given by us to you or stated in the Catalogue or, if no such estimates have been given or stated, the Reserve applicable to the Lot.

 "Notice to Bidders" the notice printed at the back or front of
- our Catalogues.
- "Purchase Price" the Hammer Price.
- "Reserve" the minimum price at which a Lot may be sold
- (whether at auction or by private treaty). "Sale" the auction sale at which a *Lot* is to be offered for sale
- "Sale Proceeds" the net amount due to the Seller from the sale of a Lot, being the Hammer Price less the Commission, any GST chargeable thereon, Expenses and any other amount due to us in whatever capacity and howsoever arising. "Seller" the person who offers the Lot for sale named on the Contract Form. Where the person so named identifies on the form another person as acting as his agent, or where the
- person named on the Contract Form acts as an agent for a principal (whether such agency is disclosed to Bonhams or "Seller" includes both the agent and the principal who shall be jointly and severally liable as such. The Seller is also referred to in the Conditions of Business by the words "you" and "your".
 "Specialist Examination" a visual examination of a Lot by a
- specialist on the Lot.
- "Stamp" means a postage stamp offered for sale at a Specialist Stamp sale.
- "Standard Examination" a visual examination of a Lot by a non specialist member of Bonhams' staff.
- "Storage Contract" means the contract described in paragraph 8.3.3 of the Conditions of Business or paragraph 4.4
- of the Buyer's Agreement (as appropriate).

 "Storage Contractor" means the company identified as such in the Catalogue.
- "Terrorism" means any act or threatened act of terrorism, whether any person is acting alone or on behalf of or in connection with any organisation(s) and/or government(s) committed for political, religious or ideological or similar purposes including, but not limited to, the intention to influence any government and/or put the public or any section of the public into fear.
- "Trust Account" the bank account of Bonhams into which all sums received in respect of the Purchase Price of any *Lot* will be paid, such account to be a distinct and separate account to Bonhams' normal business bank account. "Website" Bonhams website at www.bonhams.com.
- "Withdrawal Notice" the Seller's written notice to Bonhams revoking Bonhams' instructions to sell a *Lot*. "Without Reserve" where there is no minimum price at which
- a Lot may be sold (whether at auction or by private treaty).

GLOSSARY

The following expressions have specific legal meanings with which you may not be familiar. The following glossary is intended to give you an understanding of those expressions but is not intended to limit their legal meanings: -

- "artist's resale right": the right of the creator of a work of art to receive a payment on Sales of that work subsequent to the
- roiginal Sale of that work by the creator of it as set out in the Resale Royalty Right for Visual Artists Act 2009.

 "bailee": a person to whom goods are entrusted.

 "indemnity": an obligation to put the person who has the benefit of the indemnity in the same position in which he would have been, had the circumstances giving rise to the indemnity not arisen and the expression "indemnify" is
- construed accordingly.

 "interpleader proceedings": proceedings in the Courts to determine ownership or rights over a Lot.
- "knocked down": when a Lot is sold to a Bidder, indicated by the fall of the hammer at the Sale.
- "lien": a right for the person who has possession of the Lot to retain possession of it.
- "risk": the possibility that a Lot may be lost, damaged, destroyed, stolen, or deteriorate in condition or value. "title": the legal and equitable right to the ownership of a *Lot*.
- "tort": a legal wrong done to someone to whom the wrong doer has a duty of care.
